Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry, by payment of \$20,000. All horses shall pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$5,000 additional to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed, of which \$300,000 guaranteed to the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth and \$10,000 to fifth; 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$200,000 twice or \$300,000 once at one mile or over since May 1, 2000 allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race of \$200,000 since then or \$100,000 any distance since December 25, 2000, 4 lbs.; of \$100,000 at one mile or over in 2000-2001 or \$60,000 any distance since July 1, 2000, 6 lbs. WOODEN PHONE had good early speed and dueled along the inside, kicked clear into the stretch and held sway under urging. TIZNOW off a trifle in the air but alertly, went up to press the pace three deep, was caught four wide into and on the second turn, came under some urging as the winner slipped away nearing the stretch, then could not catch that one while clearly second best. JIMMY Z unhurried toward the inside, came out in the stretch and gained the show late. TRIBUNAL bobbled in a slow start, pulled his way along off the rail early, bid between foes and dueled into and on the second turn, then weakened in the stretch but lost third late. NURDLINGER void of early speed outside a rival until nearing the stretch, angled in for the drive and did not rally. CAPO DI CAPO sprinted between horses early and dueled between rivals, continued three deep into and on the second turn, was roused while falling back leaving that bend and gave way.
