Gray or Roan Colt, (Jan), by Exceed And Excel (AUS) - Asi Siempre by El Prado (IRE). Trainer Appleby Charles. Bred by Darley(GB).

OUTSTRIP (GB) settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, drifted from the whip in midstretch then rallied gamely under left handed urging to get up three deep approaching the wire. GIOVANNI BOLDINI stalked the pace along the inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the leader in midstretch, gained the advantage a sixteenth out, fought back between foes late and could not quite contain the winner. BOBBY'S KITTEN had speed outside a rival then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, inched clear on the backstretch, fought back along the rail in the stretch and could not match the top pair late but was clearly best of the rest. BON ACCORD four wide on the first turn, stalked three deep, went four wide again on the second turn then angled in alongside a rival into the stretch and lacked a rally. GOT SHADES saved ground chasing the pace, steadied sharply in tight and was shuffled back into the second turn, came out leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BASHART three deep into the first turn, chased between rivals off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. AOTEAROA stalked between horses, angled in midway on the second turn, dropped back in traffic leaving that turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened. POKER PLAYER angled in and settled outside a rival, continued outside on the backstretch and second turn, swung six wide into the stretch and was not a threat. WILSHIRE BOULEVARD (IRE) angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, steadied sharply when crowded midway on the second turn, steadied again leaving that turn, came out into the stretch, angled out off heels a sixteenth out and lacked the needed rally. ONTOLOGY floated four then five wide into the first turn, chased outside, came five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. SHAMSHON (IRE) broke slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the backstretch, came out again on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. HOME SCHOOL (IRE) close up stalking the pace outside a rival, dropped back between horses leaving the second turn and weakened. ALL CASH sent inside to duel then stalk the pace, continued between horses into the second turn, also dropped back on that turn and weakened.
