1 1/4 MILES. (1.47) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 *DEMOISELLE S. (GRADE II)* FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. 000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct spring or Belmont spring/summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a Graded Sweepstakes at any NYRA track in 2013. 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$100,000 at a mile or over other than restricted allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 16, 2013 with 19 Nominations. (Cloudy 36)

STOPCHARGINGMARIA in a step leaving the gate brushed with the nearest opponent, went on to assume a forward position, patiently stalked the pacesetter from the the two path for slightly more than three quarters, ranged up and challenged in earnest coming to the quarter pole, got hooked up in a three-way tussle in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, forged her way to a sliver of an advantage with an eighth to go, then showed good determination fending off another determined pair in order to preserve it. GOT LUCKY underwent a ground-saving journey, moved up into a good striking position upon departing the backstretch, cut the corner with sufficient racing room available along the rail corridor, had PENWITH drift inward slightly thereafter, tightening up things a bit nearing the eighth pole, vied with another pair for more than a furlong down the backstretch while gamely securing second. PENWITH broke alertly and established control before reaching the end of the homestretch, was rated along while cutting the pace, came under intensified during the later stages of the run around the far turn, got put to a drive a couple of jumps prior to the quarter pole, drifted into the two path at the head of the stretch, battled with vigor from between rivals from the three-sixteenths pole to the end but had to settle for the show award. LEXI MORGAN sat forwardly placed from the two path for nearly a half, got tipped into the three path as the half was being completed, took it while steadily advancing into contention from the top of the second bend to its end, was the widest and the last of three front runners spinning into the lane to get asked for run, flattened out shortly afterwards. AMERICA raced three wide around both turns, was initially put to some hand urging soon after swinging on to the backstretch, had it increase more vigorously the further she travelled towards the half mile pole, got set down midway on the far turn, lacked the needed pick up to keep pace and backed away. MLLE. MINUIT brushed start, brought up the back of the pack, was guided over to the rail midway on the backstretch, was put to solid encouragement making her way around the far turn, failed to make any headway.
