GO BLUE OR GO HOME took a short early lead, shook clear on the turn then widened under steady pressure through the stretch. SUPER CHUNKY raced in midpack, closed late turn, chased four-wide into the stretch and finished all out. DAN THE TIN MAN settled off the pace, closed late turn then rallied outside. FATAL BULLET forced the issue early, stalked on the turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. NIGHT OFFICER, well back early, was hustled late turn then rallied gamely in vain. BEAR NO JOKE pressed the pace, dropped back late turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. SOMETHING EXTRA forced the pace early, stalked on the turn then flattened out in deep stretch. BIG BAND SOUND settled off the pace, closed late turn, moved to the rail upper stretch but evened out. EXECUTIVE FIVE, up close early, was in range on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. NEXT QUESTION, off slowly, stalked the pace then tired in the stretch. ROTHKO settled off the pace, was hustled late turn then tired, in the final furlong.
