1 MILE. (Turf) (1.313) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *HILL PRINCE S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS*. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse will be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. TURF: Non-winners of \$60,000 twice on the turf in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; a graded sweepstake on the turf, 5 lbs.; a sweepstake on the turf or two races on the turf, 7 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a Sweepstake on the dirt allowed, 3 lbs.; two races on the dirt, 5 lbs.; \$36,000; or a race on the dirt, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, dirt allowances will apply and it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, June 1, 2013 with 44 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). (Clear 78)

NOTACATBUTALLAMA raced three wide on the elbow chute, rated kindly while proceeding down the backstretch, was guided inward upon reaching the full turn, continued to bide time kept at a slight distance from off the rail, picked up interest and swung five wide into the lane, took off in earnest with the runner up following suit from his inside, appeared to be the first one to reach the eighth pole, remained engaged in a spirited tussle with PLAY IT LOUD the rest of the way and gamely prevailed. PLAY IT LOUD forwardly placed and well reserved towards the inside for nearly three-quarters, commenced to angle outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole until in the three path, motored towards the pacesetter as a team with the eventual winner, fought with vigor but got denied. CHAMOIS was unsettled while amongst rivals running in the initial stages along the chute, with the rider atop with a solid grip on the reins in reaction to the tactics, went about more professionally shortly afterwards and was sent over to the rail, rode it to the quarter pole, was asked for a response angling three wide into the stretch, finished willingly to secure the show. RED RIFLE unhurried from off the inside for the opening half, picked up the pace upon departing the backstretch and closed the gap under some encouragement, swung five wide into the lane, mustered up a mild late response to take the final major check. SAYAAD stumbled badly and bumped with INFINITE MAGIC at the start, underwent a ground-saving journey thereafter and mainly improved position. INFINITE MAGIC bumped at the start, raced from off the rail and lacked the needed response. SHINING COPPER rushed up three wide under his own power to establish control, was sent over to the inside, came under pressure for the first time after completing three-quarters, turned for home under assault and soon succumbed. MICHAEL WITH US placed six wide at the head of the stretch, made no impact. SPECIAL SKILLS cut the corner under a full drive, came up empty. JOHA chased the leader from near the two path and gave way. BERNIE THE JET three wide to the quarter pole, fanned five wide into upper stretch, had little left and folded. RED ROCKER (IRE) was through after completing a half.
