1 MILE. (1.32²) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 NASHUA S. (GRADE II) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$2,500 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,250 re bate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 that will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2013. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races, 4 lbs.; a race 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 19, 2013 with 32 Nominations. (Clear 50)

CAIRO PRINCE moved up into contention three wide on the turn, unleashed a solid burst of speed to spurt off from the others coming to the quarter pole, emerged from the furlong grounds holding his biggest advantage, held on safely, driving. FINANCIAL MOGUL was grabbed hold after veering out at the start, was three wide entering the turn, tipped into the four path at the five-sixteenths pole and proceeded to be angled sharply one path wider into the stretch, came home willingly to garner the place. NOBLE MOON was bumped just after the start, brought up the back of the pack, got taken off the two path and launched a bold run leaving the midway point on the turn, eventually got fanned six wide into the stretch, still full of momentum, rallied in tandem with the runner up towards the winner, forged on ahead with good energy for a little while before flattening out in the late stages. INTENSE HOLIDAY sat reserved from off the inside during the opening stages, was four wide at the three-eighths pole, altered course towards the inside during the initial portion of the stretch drive, impeding TIZNOWFORAMERICA after making it over to the rail, lacked needed late response. JOSE SEA VIEW tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, failed to muster up the needed offering. PROTONICO four wide leaving the backstretch, failed to menace. GRAND ARRIVAL three wide entering the turn, was in the fifth path exiting it, made no headway. LOUISIANA FLYBOY off to a sluggish beginning, got fanned to the seven path travelling through the furlong grounds, made no impact. MASTER LIGHTNING saved ground on the turn and had no rally. MANHATTAN JOHNNIE disputed the pace towards the two path for almost the entire way on the bend then gave way. AWESOME WILDCAT was bumped between rivals at the start, was a pace factor at or near the two path for the opening half, backed away rapidly when done after going on for an additional furlong. TIZNOWFORAMERICA stumbled at the start, shied inward reacting to an incoming FINANCIAL MOGUL and got bumped, moved up to secure a forward position, vied for command from the inside for nearly three-quarters, had already fallen back when impeded and knocked into the rail leaving the three-sixteenths pole as INTENSE HOLIDAY was maneuvered over to the inside route, causing the pilot to check, faded after losing any remaining interest.
