1st MILES. (1.45²) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 SANTA ANITA DERBY (GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$300 each to accompany the nomination (EARLY BIRD) on or before December 22, 2012 closed with 123. Early Bird nominees to the Santa Anita Derby are automatically eligible to, the Sham Stakes (Grade III), the Robert B. Lewis Stakes (Grade II), and the San Felipe Stakes (Grade II) with nomination and starting fees waived to those stakes. Regular nominations close Saturday, March 23rd. by payment of \$2,500 each closed with 5. All horses shall pay \$1,250 to enter and \$10,000 to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed. The winner to receive \$450,000 PLUS 100 KENTUCKY DERBY POINTS, \$150,000 to second, \$90,000 to third, \$45,000 to fourth and \$15,000 to fifth. 122 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. (Clear 76)

GOLDENCENTS broke out a bit, pulled his way between horses then prompted the pace outside a rival, bid again between horses into the stretch to stalk the pace, came out on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch and went on willingly to the end. SUPER NINETY NINE sped to the early lead outside foes and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched away briefly along the rail on the second turn, dueled again into the stretch and weakened but bested the others. TIZ A MINISTER unhurried and angled to the inside early, saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and again into the stretch and improved position but was not a threat. POWER BROKER stalked the pace between horses then outside the runner-up on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. STORM FIGHTER pulled his way along outside then steadied off heels and came out four wide into the first turn, chased off the rail, angled to the inside on the second turn and had little left for the stretch. SUMMER EXCLUSIVE pulled early and stalked three deep, dropped back into and on the second turn, angled in some on that turn and gave way. DIRTY SWAGG went five wide into the first turn, settled off the rail chasing the pace, angled to the inside on the second turn and also gave way.
