TIZ A MINISTER saved ground off the pace, cut the corner with a move forward into the stretch, came a bit off the fence in deep stretch and was second best. DICE FLAVOR pulled his way up inside the winner then was taken back and came out on the first turn, stalked then bid alongside the winner on the backstretch, continued outside JAVA'S WAR leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch, then drifted in and held third. JAVA'S WAR broke outward, stalked off the rail, moved up inside on the second turn, was in a bit tight off heels nearing the quarter pole, came out for room into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch, drifted in and weakened.
