1 1/4 MILES. (1.404) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *CENTRAL BANK ASHLAND S. (GRADE I) FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD*. By subscription of \$100 each on or before February 22, 2014 or \$1,000 each on or before March 26, 2014. A Supplementary Nomination of \$25,000 each may be made at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$2,500 to enter and an additional \$2,500 to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed, of which \$300,000 to the owner of the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$50,000 to third, \$25,000 to fourth, \$15,000 to fifth and \$10,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 121 lbs. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Oaks, pursuant to the official rules for the Kentucky Oaks published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The maximum number of starters for the Central Bank Ashland will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. A silver julep cup will be presented to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, February 22, 2014 with 135 nominations. (Clear 44)

ROOM SERVICE was bumped at the start, settled inside, angled out on the second turn, moved up five wide, tipped out further entering the stretch, quickened and was up to end on even terms for the victory. ROSALIND was allowed to settle, circled six wide, opened clear with a furlong to run, kept on well and finished in a dead heat for the top spot. THANK YOU MARYLOU stalked the pace, advanced between rivals, split horses entering the stretch, loomed a danger but was unable to match strides with the top two. TESTA ROSSI (FR) settled saving ground, split horses to make her bid, but weakened during the drive. SATURDAY BLISS broke slow, was unhurried into stride, came five wide and improved position. MISS BESILU settled four wide, moved up between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. ON THE BACKSTREETS stalked the pace four wide, loomed a danger midway through the second turn but wilted in the stretch. CANDY KITTY failed to respond. SEEKING HER GLORY contended between horses for six furlongs and tired. RESISTIVITY vied for the lead three wide, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. ISTANFORD showed speed along the inside, was headed entering the second turn and gave way readily. MACAROON chased three wide for six furlongs and stopped. IRELAND showed little.
