1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 LECOMTE S. (GRADE III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 by Saturday, January 4. (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$1,000 to enter; \$1,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$200,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$36,000 allowed 2 lbs.; \$25,000, allowed 4 lbs.; \$20,000, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Lecomte Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses with the highest life time earnings at the time of passing entry box. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 4, 2014, with 82 nominations. (Clear 55)

VICAR'S IN TROUBLE went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside while under restraint, made a bid on the far turn, kicked clear while put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, changed leads when switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker, drifted towards the rail while drawing off and proved much the best while hand ridden late. ALBANO shifted out nearing the first turn, went four then three wide on that bend, settled on the outside in third position, chased while three wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and earned the place while no match for the winner. GOLD HAWK was reluctant to load, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled in fourth position, was roused while two then three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response then missed the place. ROMAN UNBRIDLED was hustled to the lead, set the pace on the inside, lost the advantage at the quarter-pole, dropped back under a drive and tired. GOT SHADES raced off the rail on the first turn, was taken in hand while behind RAINBOW TRIP onto the backstretch, lingered well off the pace, was ridden along on the far turn and failed to threaten. PLUG CATCHER went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide nearing the quarter-pole and came up empty. SILENT RULER lagged well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and showed little. RAINBOW TRIP raced inside on the first turn, dropped back early on the backstretch, was urged along while near the inside on the far turn and failed to respond. SMARTY'S ECHO broke about two lengths slow, saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and was no factor.
