Purse \$1,000,000 *LOUISIANA DERBY (GRADE II) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS.* (Foals of 2011) Early Bird Nomination Fee of \$500 due by Monday, December 16, 2013, which includes nomination fee for Lecomte Stakes (GIII) and Risen Star Stakes (GI) (Early Bird). Final nomination for Louisiana Derby closes Saturday, March 15 by subscription of \$1,000. \$5,000 to pass the entry box, \$5,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$50,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$1,000,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: Colts and Geldings 122 lbs. Fillies 117 lbs. Preference will be given in the following manner: First preference to graded or group winners in order (I,II,III), then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. The Louisiana Derby will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 15, 2014, with 89 nominations. (Cloudy 61)

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Mar), by Into Mischief - Vibrant by Vicar. Trainer Maker J. Michael. Bred by Spendthrift Farm LLC(LA).

VICAR'S IN TROUBLE contested the pace in the two path on the first turn, moved to a solo lead near the five-eighths pole, vied inside on the far turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, drew off under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip at the furlong marker and proved much the best under steady urging. INTENSE HOLIDAY was rated while just off the inside on the first turn, raced just off the pace while under some restraint, bumped with an opponent leaving the backstretch, was asked shortly thereafter, chased two then three wide, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, dropped in near the rail while under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, pursued the winner under a drive and proved no match while able to get the place. COMMANDING CURVE was bumped at the start and forced in, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, went three to four wide on the far turn, advanced at the five-sixteenths, came under the whip in upper stretch and safely secured the show. IN TROUBLE went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, shifted out midway down the backstretch and bumped with ALBANO, chased three to four wide on the far turn and weakened. ALBANO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was bumped midway down the backstretch and forced out, raced four wide while ridden along on the far turn and tired. FLAT GONE settled on the inside, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths, raced behind a rival coming to the quarter-pole, angled out in upper stretch and failed to respond. KING CYRUS raced in the two path on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, came under a stronger ride while near the inside on the far turn and was no factor. GOLD HAWK went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced two then three wide on the far turn, dropped back while in tight between rivals inside the five-sixteenths pole, was carried out in upper stretch and came up empty. LOUIES FLOWER disputed the pace on the inside, dropped back near the five-eighths pole, raced just behind the winner, bumped with INTENSE HOLIDAY leaving the backstretch, fell back while along the rail on the far turn and faded. RISE UP broke in and bumped with a rival, went five wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside with five furlongs to run, tracked the pace from that point, chased in the two path on the far turn and stopped. Following a stewards inquiry into the run down the backstretch, IN TROUBLE was disqualified from fourth and placed fifth.
