1 MILE. (1.342) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 MARTHA WASHINGTON S. FILLIES, THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries for a fee of \$1,500 with \$100,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the win ner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 in 2013-2014 allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$25,000 in 2014 allowed 7 lb s. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings, excluding money won in restricted races. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Oaks, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downss Incorporated. ARAGORN AMI bothered slightly when the leader came out early in the first turn, recovered to stalk the pace up the backstretch, engaged the leader late backstretch, put that foe away while drifting in past the furlong marker, proved best under steady handling. **EUPHROSYNE** broke sharp, got out early in the first turn when showing the way, set the pace up the backstretch, vied second turn, was giving way to the winner past the furlong marker when steadied, moved out, clearly second best. **IRELAND** back off the early pace, loomed bolding into contention while four wide late in the final turn, drifted out a bit to flatten out midstretch, modest amount of late interest. **COW CATCHER** bumped start, settled four wide in the first turn when well off the pace, continued four path, roused into the lane, went evenly to the wire in lacking a serious late kick. **REDGRASS CAT** came in, bumped **COW CATCHER** at the start, raced back, got out and was six wide into the lane, also continued in even fashion to the wire. **CHEERFUL CONTENDER** off a step slow, void of speed, raced back, improved position while never a serious threat. **KISS MOON** broke in, raced off the early pace in hand, moved slightly closer into a forward position the middle half, began to weaken far turn. **XRAY VISION** brushed start, lacked speed, moved slightly closer toward the inside far turn, gave way in the drive. **RACING HOLIDAY** forwardly placed along the inside for a half, gave way. **STREET STORY** staged a steady retreat while racing off the inside. **A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF EUPHROSYNE AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN MIDSTRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.**
