1 1/8 MILES. (1.401) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 *SOUTHWEST S. (GRADE III) THREE YEAR OLDS.* By subscription of \$500 on Friday, February 7, 2014 at \$500 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby, \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$300,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally between remaining starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2014, allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over at any time allowed 5 lbs.; \$30,000 at any distance, allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered). In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. Closed Friday, February 7, 2014 with 90 nominees. (Clear 75)

TAPITURE maintained inside position along the inside, rated in the run up the backstretch when with the first group, asked a bit, came in the three path turning for home, kicked well clear in the drive, drifted significantly, kept to task. STRONG MANDATE taken in hand into first turn, advanced to race within striking distance well off the inside, forward and four wide into the first turn, came five wide into the lane, proved no match for the winner, well clear of the rest while drifting through the final furlong. RIDE ON CURLIN seven wide when off the pace into the first turn, advanced to pressure the pace on the outside, had little left for the top two in the drive, saved the show. COASTLINE covered up in traffic much of the first three quarters, continued to rate into the far turn, roused left handed into lane, eased out, five wide, brushed into the lane, modest late interest to miss the show. TANZANITE CAT broke on top, set a moderate pace well off the inside while rating, had little left for the drive to also narrowly miss the show. BOURBONIZE unhurried for five furlongs, in some traffic midway on the second turn, moved out a bit, displayed a modest amount of late interest to improve position. WALT six wide into the first turn, raced back, advance while six wide again in the second bend, brushed into the lane, finished up evenly. FIRE STARTER back off the pace, six wide into the far turn, lost some momentum, improved slightly in the drive. SON OF DIXIE broke alertly, took back off the pace, made little impact in the drive. PAGANOL in midpack early and firmly in hand, failed to respond when called on in the drive. KENDALL'S BOY five wide into the first turn, slow to settle onto the backstretch, was finished before six furlongs. LOUIES FLOWER pulled hard in traffic and in mid pack, also gave way after four furlongs.
