LUCKY FOR YOU away alertly, stalked the leader from the outside on the backstretch, could not gain on the winner in the drive, and held well to be on even terms for the place. EMPRESS OF MIDWAY not far back early, saved ground while racing behind the leaders, also could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to dead-heat for the runner up award. D'YA KNOWWHATIMEAN rated just off the leaders swung three wide into the second turn and faltered in the drive. GEORGE'S PEACH stumbled at the break then bumped slightly with AWESOME BABY and trailed throughout.
