1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (1.41) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 *WITHERS S. (GRADE III) INNER DIRT FOR THREE YEAR OLDS*. No nomination fee. \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$5,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Withers has been selected as one of the races in the Kentucky Derby Championship Series Prep Season. The winner of the Withers will be awarded 10 points, the second place finisher 4 points, the third place finisher 2 points and the fourth place finisher 1 point. The purse is to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stake at a mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 4 lbs. a race other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 18, 2014 with 24 Nominations. (Cloudy 43)

SAMRAAT attended UNCLE SIGH from the outside while two to three wide throughout shaking away steadily in tandem from the rest of the field down the backside, had his main foe come under coaxing three furlongs out, responded in kind nearing the quarter pole still well clear of the rest, took over narrowly at that station, dug in determined through the length of the stretch as UNCLE SIGH fought stubbornly inside, shook away in the final jumps to prevail. UNCLE SIGH broke well, established the front while in the two path early on, cut the pace inside in hand attended from the outside by SAMRAAT while shaking clear in tandem with that foe from the remainder of the field, came under brief coaxing into the turn before being put to a drive three furlongs out under intensifying pressure from his main foe, cut the corner into upper stretch and was headed for command, dug in stubborn fighting on gamely through the length of the stretch in what developed into a virtual match race and was shaken off in the final strides while well clear of the rest. SCOTLAND steadied briefly when squeezed out at the start, raced three wide in pursuit from afar, commenced a long drive from the seven-sixteenths and made no headway. CLASSIC GIACNROLL broke in at the start, came under coaxing at the half mile pole, spun three wide for home and offered no response. HONORABLE JUDGE three wide throughout well off the pace in hand, came under encouragement midway on the far turn and made no impact. STREET GENT broke out at the start, tracked the pace from afar while saving ground, cut the corner into the stretch and made no impact.
